*We know that chronic pain and anxiety can be unbearable; however, if that is among your reasons for seeking medical care, we have specific policies for our patients. The policies are:*

1. Our physicians do not treat chronic pain; patients are referred to a pain management physician and/or specialist office.
2. Due to the nature of medications used for chronic pain and anxiety, our physicians will not prescribe any narcotic medications on the first (initial) visit.
3. Drug screens/lab tests are required on the same day as first (initial) visit.
4. Previous medical records will be requested for our physician's review.
5. Pain contracts will be enforced; any violation will result in dismissal from practice.
